

#### **5. Program Information:**

Our Religious Education program follows the curriculum guidelines that are provided by the Diocese of Buffalo

\*\* A detailed calendar of classes will be handed out on the first day of class as listed below. All classes are held in the St. John's School Building.

##### **Grades 1-8 Program    Sunday, 9:15 a.m.-10:15 a.m.** \*\* beginning September 15th

These grades use the *Finding God* series for the weekly sessions. Each child receives a workbook that contains the weekly lessons and pages for family use. The books will remain in the school building, but each child will receive a folder to bring papers to and from Religious Education. So please take the time to ask your child what they did in class. Supplemental materials are used in class as needed. Class sizes range from 10-25 children. **PLEASE NOTE: At dismissal time, parents are asked to come in and pick up their 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> graders, due to safety issues they will not be dismissed on their own.**

##### **High School Grade 9    Sunday, 11:45AM-1:15PM** \*\*beginning September 15th

The textbook Catholic Essentials is being used this year. Classes are 1.5 hours and the topics covered are: Jesus Christ in Scripture, Who Is Jesus?, Paschal Mystery; The Mission of Jesus, The Church; Christ's Mission Continues in the World Today, Sacraments of Christ and Our Life in Christ

##### **Confirmation 10<sup>th</sup> Grade    Sundays 11:45AM-1:15PM** \*\***Parent Meeting Sunday, TBD 11:45AM in the Church Hall**

Students that are in 10<sup>th</sup> grade and have had good attendance in 9<sup>th</sup> grade and attend Mass on a regular basis are eligible to participate in the Confirmation program. This program will be a combination of class experiences at local Catholic churches with the class and also classes to prepare for Confirmation. The Mass experience reinforces the idea that we are a global church. The Confirmation instruction portion of the program involves the immediate preparation of the candidates for the sacrament and classes are held in St. John's School building. Pflaum publishing materials are used with this program.
